THE 23:23 LEADERSHIP PROGRAM?

Over the course of four months, participants will receive professional growth opportunities through live sessions and 1:1 mentorship*. Live sessions will be led by DSCI experts & women in supply chain leadership positions. In addition, there will be monthly peer group activities for networking and problem-solving.

Participants who successfully engage in the live sessions will have access to a senior women supply chain leader as their mentor. The mentor will be available for 1:1 meetings, providing you with personalized guidance and support as you navigate the challenges and opportunities of your professional growth.
